

CPOE for Medication Order

More than 30% of medication orders created by the EP during the EHR reporting period are recorded using CPOE (Computerized Physician Order Entry). The CPOE must be directly entered by any licensed healthcare professional that can enter orders into the medical record per state, local and professional guidelines.

How to meet this measure using ONCOCHART –

You can create a CPOE medication order in ONCOCHART by utilizing ePrescribe for all of your medications. Make sure to sign your prescriptions, so the information flows back into ONCOCHART. This is the only way we can calculate this measure.
