

Record Smoking Status

More than 50% of all unique patients 13 years old or older seen by the EP have smoking status recorded as structured data.

How to meet this measure using ONCOCHART –

You can record the smoking status of a patient in an INI and an FUE under the *Social History* tab and under the *MU Smoking Query* group.
