

Syndromic Surveillance Data Submission (public health)

Performed at least one test of CEHRTs capacity to provide electronic syndromic surveillance data to public health agencies and follow up submission if the test is successful (unless none of the public health agencies to which the EP, EH, or CAH submits such information have the capacity to receive the information electronically).

According to CMS, providers should contact their local or state public health agency for information and instructions on submitting public health related data to satisfy the Meaningful Use measures (See CMS FAQ #3605 <https://questions.cms.gov/faq.php?id=5005&faqId=3605>).

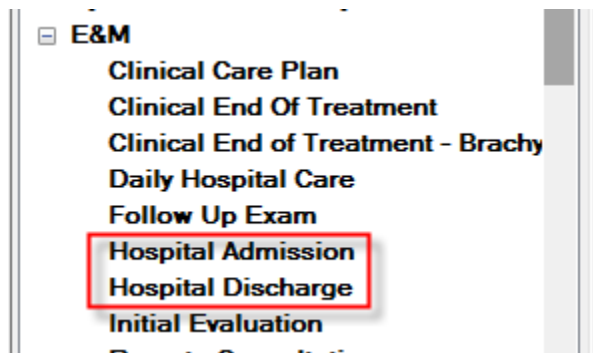
Contact your local or state public health agencies regarding submitting syndromic surveillance data for MU. If it is determined that you're in a category of physicians who should submit this information, contact ONCOCHART Support and inform us that you would like to meet this measure. We'll need to setup a syndromic surveillance interface.

How to meet this measure using ONCOCHART -

When applicable, fill out and record a Hospital Admission narrative and a Hospital Discharge narrative.

Once recorded, a syndromic surveillance HL7 message will be generated.

For better adherence, it would be best to diagnose and stage the patient before recording these narratives. It would also be best to populate the patient's problem list with as much up to date information as you can obtain.
