

Use Secure Electronic Messaging

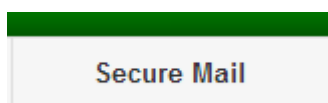
A secure message was sent using the electronic messaging function of CEHRT by more than 5% of unique patients (or their authorized representatives) seen by the EP during the EHR reporting period.

You must be subscribed to the patient portal to meet this measure. *Contact ONCOCHART support for more information regarding the patient portal.*

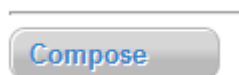
How to meet this measure using ONCOCHART –

Walk your patients through the process of sending a secure message, to his/her radiation oncologist, from the patient portal.

Ask the patient to log into the patient portal at <https://patient.oncochart.com>




Click on *Secure Mail*
