



Public Health Reporting - Syndromic Surveillance Reporting

The MIPS eligible clinician is in active engagement with a public health agency to submit syndromic surveillance data.

Contact your local or state public health agencies regarding submitting immunization data for MU/MIPS. You can also go to your state health department’s website and search for Meaningful Use, or you can Google “(Insert state name) health department MU”.

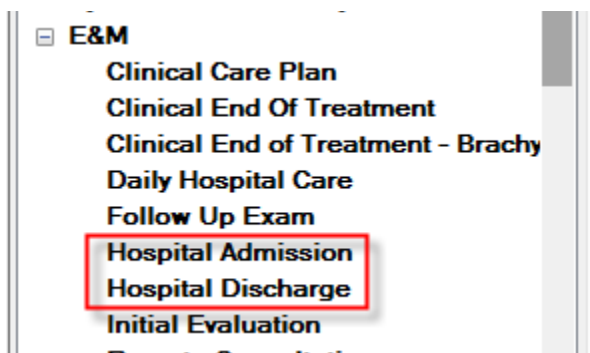
If you’ve determined that you’re in a category of physicians who should submit this information, contact ONCOCHART Support and inform us that you would like to meet this measure. We’ll need to setup a syndromic surveillance interface.

How to meet this measure using ONCOCHART –

When applicable, fill out and record a Hospital Admission narrative and a Hospital Discharge narrative.

Once recorded, a syndromic surveillance HL7 message will be generated.

For better adherence, it would be best to diagnose and stage the patient before recording these narratives. It would also be best to populate the patient’s problem list with as much up to date information as you can obtain.
